*"Humbly we adore thee, Christ, Redeemer, King;
Thou art Lord of heaven, thou to whom we sing.
God, the Mighty, thou has come,
bearing gifts of grace;
Son of Adam still thou art: Savior to our race."*

St. Thomas Aquinas wrote these words for the Feast of Corpus Christi in the 13th Century. He attempts to bring words to praise the WORD made Flesh, who has given to the world his Body and Blood that we might share in the mystery of his life. **The love of God for the human race is so tremendous that the Incarnation was not enough.** The Incarnate One, Jesus Christ, has given us his Body to eat and his Blood to drink so that we possess in our souls the mysterious grace of God Himself to heal, strengthen and form us into his Divine Life. Yet, for some this reality is a hard saying, "How can he give us his Body and Blood as Food and Drink?" The Bishops of the United States have acknowledged that many believers find this a hard saying in the world today. They have encouraged the whole Church, Dioceses, Parish Churches, and individual believers to work to revive the joy and love of this Gift of the Holy Eucharist and draw them back to the love of God.

For most of us, the sacramental event we remember the most is the reception of our First Holy Communion. That day was full of joy because we were able, for the first time, to approach the Altar and receive the Body of Christ from the hands of the priest. We knew that we were not receiving a host of bread, but the Body of Jesus Christ, which not only united us to God, but to all who share in the Holy Mass. We know that because we were taught the Words of Jesus said at the Last Supper. **"Take this all of you and eat of it, for this is my Body. Take this all of you and drink of it, for this is my Blood!"** We learned that although the appearance of bread is seen, it is the Son of God himself who is received. We knew that for the rest of our lives, if we stay close to God in grace, we can receive Him at every Mass we attend. We also learned that we can visit Jesus himself in the Tabernacle in Church

How can a Radio Station help revive our devotion to the Holy Eucharist? Sacred Heart Radio, from its beginning, has stressed the Eucharistic life not only by our daily broadcasting of the Mass, but also through our local and national

programs which speak of the Mystery of the Holy Eucharist. It is our hope that not only do we adore the Lord with our eyes when we sit before the Blessed Sacrament, we can learn to adore the Lord through our ears when we hear every day Jesus' own Words that bring light and life to our souls.

Daily devotion to the Eucharist through the Mass, Adoration, and listening to Sacred Heart Radio, can help all of us to deepen our faith, increase our hope and renew our love for God.

You'll be reading in this newsletter our initial plans for how Sacred Heart Radio would like to contribute to the Eucharistic Revival in parishes.

These are times when our faith is paramount and it is by a new devotion to the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ that it can happen. St. Thomas Aquinas expressed it well:

*"Faith alone reveals here bread of Paradise;
Faith alone may witness Jesus' sacrifice.
Therefore, Lord, as once of old Thomas gained
his sight, Now increase our feeble faith;
shed thy healing light."*

SEEN and UNSEEN

Just about the time THE NEW sacredheartradio.com launches, with the ability to show who we're talking with on the *Son Rise Morning Show* and *Driving Home the Faith*, we'll also be engaging in a **NEW WAY** to play the sounds you hear.

Yes, **DAD** (digital audio delivery) our new automation software, will allow a number of important audio upgrades that are long overdue. For instance, no longer will there be the need for several computers to do the task of one.

With DAD we can pre-schedule the recordings of all our interviews and can automatically edit them to our parameters.

Ever since the Son Rise Morning Show went national, two computers and precise manual switching was needed to send audio to EWTN affiliates while our local breaks were playing. But now, at a prescribed time, DAD commands the audio console to split into two separate audio feeds, play the content and then recombine into one feed again without human (Paul Lachmann) intervention.

In addition to that, we'll no longer need THREE computers to record and edit the daily Mass from St Gertrude in Madeira. It will still be necessary to manually edit to remove large portions of silence, but the ability to record, edit and playback from one source will be a time saving blessing.

There are a number of other special tools that the new software can perform, as well--some we will probably never use.

But just in case, it's good to know that if we need to send multiple audio feeds at different times to anywhere in the world, DAD will always deliver-- ON TIME!

Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

If ever you question whether God has His hand on history, I present to you June 24, 2022, when two solemnities landed on the same day: **The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist**. On that day the Supreme Court issued the decision that overturned *Roe v. Wade* - a day that we as Catholics could celebrate the fire of God's love for mankind, and the birthday of John the Baptist, who as an unborn child first confessed Christ, who was also an unborn child.

You may recall that I was on maternity leave for the entirety of June - well, except for the Monday following the Dobbs decision, because I couldn't miss talking about it! I was sitting on my couch with a three week old baby on my lap as I refreshed the Supreme Court's website that morning. It was a really emotional moment to read the decision of the Court and look down at that baby, knowing that she is literally in the Post-Roe Generation... and knowing that so many babies like her will be allowed to live because of this.

The overturning of *Roe v. Wade* was the result of decades of prayer and vigilance, but we know that the fight for Life is not over. Not only have we seen much of the political class doing all they can to expand access to abortion, the Dobbs decision has also exposed a number of major corporations that were willing to financially participate in employees obtaining abortions in other states.

Even though these companies may have had a long-standing policy of assisting their workers in covering the travel expenses to obtain the

best medical care available, by *publicizing* their readiness to pay for abortion, it has caused many Catholic organizations, including Sacred Heart Radio, to sever our official association with them.

We don't need to call them out by name, you know who they are. Anyway, it's not what you hear, but what you **don't hear** --that speaks volumes. Shopping is one thing, but we decided that in advertising and earning a commission from them, we could give the impression that Sacred Heart Radio is participating in their mission (co-mission).

Of course, cutting ties with these sponsors means the commissions we received are gone as well. That's OK, because as followers of Christ we are assured that whatever we give up for the Kingdom of God will be returned to us, 10—30—100 times, packed down and overflowing!
