"Thus should one regard us: as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. Now it is of course required of stewards that they be found trustworthy." (1 Cor 4:1-2)

St. Paul was sent by the Lord to be the Missionary to the Gentile people (non-Jews) of the world. His message is simple: **Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified, has been raised from the dead and is now seated at the Father's right hand.** He is a personal witness to this event. He shares with the people of Corinth that he has been entrusted with a priceless treasure, not silver, gold or rare jewels. He has been entrusted with the mysteries and secrets of God! These mysteries include the life and words and deeds of Jesus of Nazareth, who has been revealed to him as the Lord and Savior of the human race. He is the Son of God who with the Father sends the Holy Spirit to bestow this precious treasure upon all who have faith in Him. **Every baptized person becomes a steward of these powerful gifts.** Once Paul has invoked the power of the Holy Spirit on those who are baptized, he must explain to them what they have been given and how they are to use them.

Sacred Heart Radio shares in this mission of St. Paul and the whole Church. **Sacred Heart Radio has taken this stewardship to the airwaves for 23 years from Northern Kentucky through Cincinnati, all the way to Dayton and beyond.** By our baptism, we too are stewards of the mysteries of God. The Season of Lent is an opportunity for us to recall what we have received and pass on what we have learned through our prayers and interactions with others. These Holy Mysteries are described in the Epistle of St. John: "What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we looked upon and touched with our hands concerns the Word of life—for the life was made visible; we have seen it and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life that was with the Father and was made visible to us—what we have



seen and heard we proclaim now to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; for our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ."

You too are Stewards of the Mysteries of God! You too are precious links in the unbreakable chain of faith that unites us through the Holy Spirit! Getting Heard and SEEN

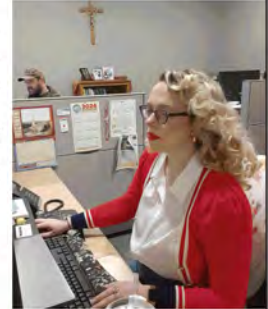
In an effort to "seek and find" those who haven't yet discovered Sacred Heart Radio, we have hired a new Director of Marketing, Halie Chrysler-Barr.
