
"You will show me the path to life, abounding joy in your presence, delights at your right hand forever." (PSALM 16:11)

His words also affected his disciples so deeply that in the Acts of the Apostles, the followers of Jesus were known as "THE WAY."

"WAY" of Jesus, we learn quickly that it is the WAY of **the Cross.** It is a path of service and humility, compassion and forgiveness, Justice and Truth. It is ultimately the path of self-emptying Love that Jesus himself walked on the path to Calvary. This is THE WAY to Salvation and THE WAY to Glory with Him in Heaven.


