THE HOMECOMING

*"I rejoiced when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the LORD.'
And now our feet are standing within your gates, Jerusalem. (Psalm 122:1-2)*

The goal of our life is to live in the House of the Lord forever. The ultimate House of the Lord is **Heaven**. Until we reach that point at the end of our lives, Sacred Scripture tells us of certain spots along the journey of salvation history.

For the people of Israel, their home was on Mt. Zion, the Temple of Jerusalem. They dwelt there but they were eventually cast out because of their sins. After years of exile, the Lord called them to return and rebuild the House of the Lord.

When the fullness of time had arrived, God sent his Son to be born of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and she conceived the Son of God in her womb by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The house where Mary lived when the Angel Gabriel announced she was to be the Mother of God, was in the city of Nazareth. That house is now known as the House of Loreto, because this home was believed to have been miraculously moved, from Nazareth to Loreto, Italy. The house of Loreto is a place where pilgrims arrive to venerate and touch the stones of the Holy House of Mary. The House of Loreto is now a Church, where the lighted candle burns to not only announce the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, but to scatter the darkness and announce the Light of Christ to the world.

If we believe that "home is where the heart is," then this home is the place of two Hearts, the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the Sacred Heart of Jesus. 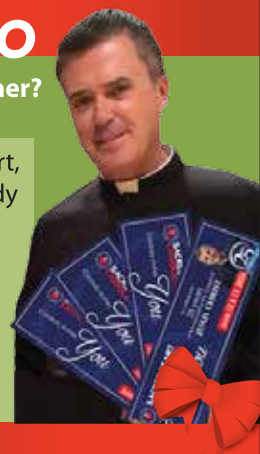
