Catholic Churches are still filled on Christmas Eve, but the impression of many is that the Mass is something we do BEFORE Christmas, rather than realizing that the Mass itself IS Christmas. We worship the Christ child because we know that he is our God and Savior. We hear the word of God and recall that God comes into history to make it holy and elevate it as a means to see the depth of God's desire to restore us to himself. Finally, we have the grace to receive the Body and Blood of the Son of God.

That child who slept in his mother's arms will give his life on the cross so that *His Body and Blood will become* the greatest Christmas Gift any human being can ever receive.

Commercially zoned land in the I-275 loop is very expensive. However, there is a half acre plot on Beechmont Avenue near St. Thomas More Church that could work and is at the right price. Maybe we'll buy it...

When we bought 89.5 it was to "fill in" where 740 AM was restricted from reaching, but since we increased the power of 89.5 several years ago, you can hear our FM in more places than just the Tri-County area.

You may hear other stations that share 89.5 "fence posting" in and out while listening, but getting a little relief from hearing the "oldies" underneath Matt and Annie is welcome, until your commute brings you closer to downtown where 740 is stronger.

The FM has been picked up as far away as New Richmond and Batavia, but comes in like a freight train in Blue Ash and other locations nearer to Fairfield and Hamilton. So TRY 89.5 FM in January and July or use **BLUETOOTH** to stream us from your phone to your car radio through the Sacred Heart Radio APP!
