## THE FACE OF G

"I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance." --Luke 15:7

A few weeks ago, the Magnificat published a reflection on this verse from the founder of the Focolare Movement, Servant of God Chiara Lubich. In it, she lamented that many of us are easily discouraged by our sins, not because we're truly sorry for offending God but actually because we failed: A sign of pride that we "are relying more on ourselves than on the infinite mercy of Jesus and on the power of his grace."

This points us right to the heart of Lent, doesn't it? We remind ourselves that we are dust, and to dust we shall return, and we enter the desert with Jesus. We practice the pillars of prayer, fasting and almsgiving to help us to strip away all the excess "stuff" in our lives that give us the illusion of control, and we offer it all to the Lord. Beyond that, we are asked to give our whole self (faults and all) to him who emptied his whole self on the cross for our salvation.

Lubich writes, "Jesus will completely cancel out our sins, and with this it means that we get up immediately and follow him. We must concretely and beyond all limits believe in the mercy of Jesus; we must give him the gift of our nothingness each time our shortcomings and weaknesses give us the chance to do so..." saying, "Further, we must be convinced that this would be the most beautiful response we could give to his love."



In fact, she says, if there is so much joy over one repentant sinner like you or me, shouldn't we "return over and over again into the arms of God's mercy? For a world so torn to pieces by thousands of evils and dangers, couldn't this be a way to draw down God's blessings?"

What a profound opportunity we have all through the year, but especially during Lent, to draw down blessings from heaven simply by throwing ourselves upon the mercy of God! Such is the power of Confession and the Holy Eucharist.

Lubich says, "Many Christians believe in God's mercy because they learned of it in their catechisms, but their belief has remained only on a conceptual or intellectual level and thus has not been able to penetrate their everyday lives." It is our mission at Sacred Heart Radio to go beyond broadcasting the facts of our Catholic Faith - to help us all move those facts from the head to the heart and allow the Faith to inform all aspects of our lives. Whether it be through the insights from all the incredible guests you hear on the Son Rise Morning Show, or the reflections from Fr. Rob Jack (and his guests, too!) on Driving Home the Faith, you can bet that if you take the challenge to "switch to Catholic Radio for Lent," you will find (for one) that it's not as big a penance as you might think, and indeed, you will find yourself better prepared - and eager to receive our Risen Lord at Easter.

Servant of God Chiara Lubich, pray for us! Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!

## UPGRADE UPDATE

**N**ow that we have been in the new studios for a year, over the last few months we've identified TWO major upgrades necessary to complete the project.

One of these upgrades is the installation of new automation software & hardware to play all the recorded audio content you hear on Sacred Heart Radio. The reason this \$20,000 investment is necessary now, is because the automation software we relied on for two decades has become obsolete and can only run on Windows 7! The new software, known as DAD (digital audio delivery) also give us the advantage of being able to interface with our new broadcast console to automate several functions we now have to do manually, and much more. Because of the rather steep learning curve of the new software, a DAD rep will be here on-site for two days of intensive training with the entire staff.

Another necessary upgrade is a new HVAC system for the studios. The present system is over 30 years old. Because of this, the air ducts are not large enough or insulated and the fan speed cannot be slowed down enough to silence the rumble and distracting fan noise in the studios. The new system will cost about \$30,000 and when installed, (depending on supply chain availability) will not only give additional cooling in the control room where several major components are housed, but also afford the benefit of ZERO fan noise. Even though you may not have been able to hear any noise and rumble on-air now, having quieter studios, especially when several mics are hot, will be yet another "listening enhancement" that was our ultimate goal with the construction of the new studios.

We will also be investing this year in new LED tower lights for 740's three broadcast towers. With the number of towers going up, getting someone scheduled to change the side lights and top beacons every few years is becoming increasingly difficult.



Even though we'll need to string new wiring for the LED's, they should last for decades, making the one-time \$9,000 investment well worth it.

Of course, all these improvements were made possible by YOU! 
