



construction and to equip the new studios came to roughly \$280,000. Yes, we spent a "little more" than hoped in order to do it right, but when divided over the last 18 years since our first studio build, you can see we've been as frugal as possible with your gifts in our FIRST 20 years!

You may remember that the funds to acquire 89.5 FM came from a number of pledges we accumulated prior to the auction for the station, and 910 AM was bought when we sold a Cell Tower that was included in the purchase 740 AM. Several other notable big ticket items and improvements, like the two technical studies to increase the power of 740 AM

on 740's three towers were taken from the proceeds collected from several conferences we've held over the years.

Underwriting revenue helped to pay the salaries of the staff we added to begin producing the Son Rise Morning Show and later Driving Home the Faith, so as to create the best programs available to enrich your spiritual growth and enhance the quality of your listening experience.

Now, unlike the special funds raised in the past, the funds for the new studios came from the dollars we have saved over two decades in case we ever had a shortfall in collections and needed it to keep operating. Thanks to your faithful contributions over all these years, it was never spent, until now.
