This year, while other businesses were downsizing due to the pandemic, Sacred Heart Radio has been in the midst of a major expansion, allowing us to triple our square footage and upgrade to the most state of the art broadcast equipment available. Although it was tempting to apply the brakes and wait for the "all clear", moving forward on this project now has apparently been God's plan all along, to serve as a great teaching moment in trust.

That said, it hasn't all been smooth sailing. Like most construction projects, we ran into a few "obstacles" that required a complete redraw of the floor plans TWICE! The obstacles were noisy A/C units that were positioned directly above where the studios were to be located. We tinkered with the idea of moving the units, until the \$35,000 estimates came in! It was then we discovered that by moving the location of the studios, not only would it mean a significant savings to the budget, but it would also allow us to have an outside' window in the TALK ROOM STUDIO where we produce five hour of local programming every weekday. After all, how can you accurately report on what's going on outside--from inside a closet?

As you know, the Son Rise **Morning Show** is heard nationally, but it's only the first hour that is carried on the **EWTN Global Catholic Radio** Network, with the other two hours heard exclusively on our three local stations.

Well, our national audience has enjoyed the program so much that quite a few managers from other stations around the country have been asking, for some time now, whether we would consider feeding them a second hour of the morning show. And with the studio and equipment upgrades squarely in sight, we are finally be able to make that happen.

Plans are tentative at the moment, but we're aiming to offer our second syndicated hour around the first of year. It will be a small launch initially, with the Son Rise Morning Show in a few test markets to begin with. Assuming all goes well, we'll start reaching out to other stations who have expressed interest.

Don't worry, we'll still provide local traffic and weather reports, along with the latest news and sports.

There's still a good amount of planning and coordinating with the others stations before we're ready to go live, so please keep this network expansion in your prayers. We'll have an update on our progress in Sacred Heart Radio's Christmas Newsletter.


